Team teaching also ensured children were getting more adult input and they were therefore move learning on more quickly. Staff are now equipped with the skills and confidence to carry out these lessons without support enabling our current apprentice to further develop other areas of P.E. P.E apprentice also supported EYFS with their physical activities outside on a daily basis. A good proportion of children exceeding the physical development early learning goal, significantly higher than national average. Comments from P.E specialists (including sports partnership managers) indicated the reception children were demonstrating excellent skills when working on a range of activities.
